HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL:

IR Griffith Primary opened its doors for the first time on 18 January 1966. There was an enrolment of 285 children ranging from Grade One to Grade Four. The acting principal was the late Miss Ruth Shaer and the Chairman of the School Committee was Mr IR Griffith. At a general meeting of prospective parents in November 1965, it was decided to honour Mr IR Griffith by naming the school after him. He was a retired Chief Inspector of Education and a Blairgowrie resident.



SCHOLASTIC INFORMATION:

IR Griffith Primary follows the National Curriculum Statement Grade R-12, in particular the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS). This curriculum aims to ensure that children acquire and apply knowledge and skills in ways that are meaningful to their own lives. In this regard, the curriculum promotes knowledge in local contexts, while being sensitive to global imperatives. We promote inclusivity in our school with two LSEN classes (Learners with special Educational Needs) where the DCAPS (Differentiated Curriculum and Assessment Policy) is taught. Teaching and learning at IR Griffith Primary School is centred on the holistic development of every child. We are committed to nurturing confident, compassionate, and capable learners, equipping them with the knowledge, skills, and values needed to thrive as responsible global citizens.



SCHOOL TIMES:

In the mornings, school starts at 07:35. Susman and Ralda Road gates close at 07:35 when the first bell rings. In the afternoons the Grades finish as follows: Grade 1 and 2 at 13:20; Grade 3 at 13:50; Grade 4 to 7 at 14:20. Grade R learners finish at 13:00.

UNIFORM:

Every child is expected to be attired correctly when attending school. The uniform is available at the school office and stockists. A list of our stockists will be provided on acceptance of your child's application.

EXTRAMURAL ACTIVITIES:

The extramural programme is an integral part of the education that a child receives at school. Every child is encouraged to take part in at least one activity per term. Such participation helps the child not only to acquire new skills but also to integrate happily within the school community. Among the extramural activities offered are: Athletics, Choir, Cricket, Cross Country, Eisteddfod, Hockey, Netball, Public Speaking, Soccer and Swimming. IR Griffith prides itself on not only academic development but extramural participation as well. All extra-murals are included in the school fees. Extra mural activities are seasonal.



FACILITIES:

The school has an extensive range of modern audio-visual equipment. There are well-equipped Design and Technology, Music and Art rooms, a Science Laboratory, library and the IRG Wellness Centre. The IRG Wellness Centre meets the psychological needs of the learners and their families. They offer the following services: Psychological Assessments, Play Therapy and Counselling. The school also uses the services of an Occupational Therapist and a Speech Therapist.

The school has extensive playing fields. There are two cricket fields, three cricket nets and a full-sized athletics track. Three soccer fields and three netball/tennis courts are on site. The school has a swimming pool centre that is used by all children.

NEWSLETTER:

IRG makes use of the D6 Connect app and class or grade WhatsApp groups to communicate important information to the parents such as the year calendar, the weekly newsletter and the extramural timetable.

FEES:

Grade 1 to 7 school fees for 2026 are R29 500 for the year. Grade R school fees for 2026 are R34 750 for the year. Aftercare fees are included in the Grade R fee package.

A deposit of R3000 is payable in November for the fees for the following year. The fees for 2027 will be decided at the budget meeting held in November 2026.

STATIONERY FEE:

Stationery packs containing the items needed for Grade R and Grade 1 will be prepared for your child. This is a compulsory pack which needs to be purchased from the school. (Grade R for 2026 was R850 and Grade 1 R1350). The 2027 prices will be given out at a later date.

AFTERCARE:



Aftercare is offered at our school and various payment options are available. Aftercare offers supervised homework. Aftercare is open from 13:00 until 17:30 each school day. During the holidays, the Centre opens at 07:15 and closes at 17:30. If you intend to make use of the Aftercare Facility, it is important that you contact them.
